On behalf of RAPDASA, the Vaal University of Technology, together with its collaborators, takes pride in announcing RAPDASA 2011, the 12^{th} Annual International RAPDASA Conference, to be held from 2 - 4 November at the Riverside Hotel and Conference Centre, Vanderbijlpark.

A pre-conference Mimics Innovation Workshop will be presented by Materialise NV from Leuven, Belgium, on 31 October and 1 November 2011.

RAPDASA 2011 will focus on the impact of AM on the complete product development process / value chain. Therefore, participants are invited to submit papers that address AM's impact on new product development for the peer review process. Suggested topics include design, simulation, modeling, virtual prototyping and digital sculpting, direct manufacturing of consumer, artistic and industrial products, tooling, medical applications, business models, business cases and educational development.

The conference will be hosted at the Riverside Hotel and Conference Centre, Vanderbijlpark, with an all-inclusive package of R5200.00 per delegate, which includes:

Pre-conference workshop:

It is suggested that participants interested in the pre-conference workshop arrive at 09:00 on the morning of 31^{st} October, and that hotel accommodation be used for the evening of the 31^{st} as well. A pre-conference package, including attendance of the two days inclusive of accommodation, lunches and dinner is available at R1750.00 per delegate (full-time students can attend for R1200).

Attendance of the workshop only will be R500 per delegate per day.

Publishing of papers:

The peer review process will be led by Dr Willie du Preez, as chair of the technical committee, and all accepted papers will be published electronically. A best-paper award will be made by the Rapid Prototyping Journal (RPJ), with publication of the selected paper in the RPJ. Selected papers will be published in applicable journals, to be announced.
