Deadline	<b>Scholarships for Staff, Masters and PhD students</b>
Focus areas	<p>EUROS+ scholarships are available in a broad range of fields of study. Apart from the study areas in 'Art &amp; Design', 'Humanities' and 'Languages &amp; Philological Sciences', all study fields are open to South African applicants.</p> <p>The detailed academic offer for Master and <u>PhD</u> applicants is available according to study field or destination in the application database.</p> <p><a href="#">Study Fields for South African applicants</a></p>
Eligibility	<p>Only South African nationals are eligible to apply for a EUROS+ scholarship. Permanent residents who do not have the South African nationality cannot apply.</p> <p>South African Master, PhD or Staff applicants from a South African partner university should apply as Target Group 1 applicants.</p> <p>South African Master and PhD applicants from non-partner universities or who are currently working with a previous degree from a South African university should apply as Target Group 2 applicants.</p>

	<p>The EUROSAs+ partnership specifically encourages applicants from historically disadvantaged groups to apply for a scholarship.</p> <p>Please note that you are not eligible to apply for a scholarship if you have resided in a European member state for more than 12 months over the past 5 years.</p>
Financial range	<p>The EUROSAs+ partnership will award 69 grants to support South African mobility to a European partner university at Master, PhD and Staff level.. The duration of the mobility varies from 1 to 34 months according to the level and the type of mobility. (exchange, study or research). Grants include a monthly subsistence allowance to cover your accommodation and living expenses, health insurance, participation fees (if applicable) and travel costs.</p> <p>The scholarship includes:</p> <p>Subsistence allowance</p> <p>1.000 EUR per month for Master students (R15 000 – depending on the exchange rate)</p> <p>1.500 EUR per month for PhD students (R22 500)</p> <p>2.500 EUR per month for Staff (R37 500)</p> <p>Insurance coverage</p> <p>Participation fees (if applicable)</p> <p>One return airticket .</p>
Applications	<p><b>The EUROSAs + programme is coordinated by the University of Antwerp (Belgium) and the Cape Peninsula University of Technology (South Africa). Applicants have to apply online and submit their applications by the deadline date. No late applications will be accepted</b></p>
