Eligibility	<p>Only South African citizens studying/working at any South African higher education institution wishing to do a Master, PhD or Staff exchange</p> <p>Employed South African citizens studying part time at a South African higher education institution wishing to do a Master or PhD.</p> <p>Please note that you are not eligible to apply for a scholarship if you have resided in a European member state for more than 12 months over the past 5 years.</p>
Financial range	<p>The SATURN scholarship is an award to support South African mobility to a European partner university at Master, PhD and Staff level. The duration of the mobility varies from 1 to 34 months according to the level and the type of mobility. (exchange, study or research). Grants include a monthly subsistence allowance to cover your accommodation and living expenses, health insurance, participation fees (if applicable) and travel costs.</p> <p>The scholarship includes:</p> <p>Subsistence allowance</p> <p>1.000 EUR per month for Master students (R15 000 – depending on the exchange rate)</p> <p>1.500 EUR per month for PhD students (R22 500)</p> <p>2.500 EUR per month for Staff (R37 500)</p> <p>Health and Travel Insurance coverage</p> <p>Tuition fee waivers</p> <p>One return flight ticket to Europe .</p>
Applications	<p>The EU-SATURN programme is coordinated by the University of Groningen (The Netherlands) and the University of the Free State (South Africa). Applicants have to apply online and submit their applications by the deadline date. No late applications will be accepted.</p>
