'A CRISIS OF LEADERSHIP? REFLECTIONS ON 20 YEARS OF DEMOCRACY'

aangebied deur prof Maxi Schoeman

In hierdie lesing besin prof Schoeman oor die vordering – plaaslik en internasionaal – wat Suid-Afrika die afgelope twee dekades gemaak het, asook oor die struikelblokke en uitdagings waaroor die land aan die begin van die derde dekade van demokrasie te staan kom. Vanuit die hoek van leierskap en magskompetisie ondersoek sy die redes vir die toenemende krisiservaring wat die gemeenskap kenmerk. Sy redeneer dat baie van die probleme wat Suid-Afrika in die gesig staar, soos korruksie, die verswakkering van staatsinstellings en toenemende armoede en ongelykheid, die gevolge is van 'n onopgeloste klassestryd wat sal voortduur weens 'n gebrek aan sterk, visioenêre, hegemoniese leierskap. Ten slotte plaas prof Schoeman die tersiêre sektor midde in dié voortgesette stryd en maak voorstelle oor hoe UP, as deel van hierdie landskap, tussenbeide kan tree met leierskapsgroeperings wat 'n bydrae kan lewer om die krisis op te los.

Prof Maxi Schoeman het 'n PhD aan die Universiteit van Wallis (Aberystwyth) behaal. Sy het in 2000 by die Universiteit van Pretoria aangesluit as professor en hoof van die Departement Politieke Wetenskappe en dien tans ook as voorstander van die Kernvakgroep vir die Sosiale Wetenskappe in die Fakulteit Geesteswetenskappe. Sy is lid van die Universiteitsraad en assosiaat-professor in die Skool vir Openbare Beleid aan George Mason-universiteit in die Verenigde State. Sy was navorsingsgenoot aan Cambridge-universiteit (1995/96), die Copenhagen-vredesnavorsingsinstituut (2001), die Dag Hammarskjöld-stigting (2009) en die Nordiese Afrika-instituut (2009). Die 2014-Claude Ake-Besoekende Leerstoel aan die Universiteit van Uppsala is onlangs aan prof Schoeman toegeken en sy sal die posisie in Augustus vanjaar opneem. Sy het gaslesings en seminare aan onder meer die universiteite van Copenhagen, Aalborg, Konstanz, Indiana en Beijing aangebied. Sy behou noue navorsingsbande met die Afrika-leierskapsentrum in Nairobi en die Kofi Annan-Internasjonale Opleidingscentrum vir Vredeshandhawing in Accra. Sy is lid van die raad van die Afrika-vredesnetwerk van die New Yorkse Navorsingsraad vir Sosiale Wetenskappe en dien op die redaksionele rade van verskeie plaaslike en internationale joernale oor internasionale betrekkinge.

presented by Prof Maxi Schoeman

In this lecture Prof Schoeman reflects on the many gains made by South Africa – domestically and internationally – over the past two decades, and on the constraints and challenges facing the country at the dawn of its third decade of democracy. Using the lens of leadership and power contestation, she explores the reasons for an increasing sense of crisis permeating society. She argues that many of the ills facing South Africa, such as corruption, the weakening of state institutions and the deepening of poverty and inequality, are the consequences of an unresolved class struggle which, in turn, will continue to rage ever more stridently owing to the lack of strong, visionary, hegemonic leadership. In conclusion Prof Schoeman situates the tertiary sector within this ongoing struggle and makes some suggestions as to how UP, as part of this landscape, can intervene to provide pockets of leadership that could assist in a resolution of the crisis.

Prof Maxi Schoeman holds a PhD from the University of Wales (Aberystwyth). She joined the University of Pretoria in 2000 as professor and head of the Department of Political Sciences and currently also serves as chair of the Core Social Sciences cluster in the Faculty of Humanities. She is a member of the University Council and an adjunct professor in the School for Public Policy at George Mason University in the United States. She held research fellowships with Cambridge University (1995/96), the Copenhagen Peace Research Institute (2001), the Dag Hammarskjöld Foundation (2009) and the Nordic Africa Institute (2009). She was recently awarded the 2014 Claude Ake Visiting Chair at the University of Uppsala, a position that she will take up in August this year. She has presented guest lectures and seminars at, amongst others, the Universities of Copenhagen, Aalborg, Konstanz, Indiana and Beijing. She maintains close research ties with the African Leadership Centre in Nairobi and the Kofi Annan International Peacekeeping Training Centre in Accra. She is a member of the Advisory Board of the African Peace Network of the Social Sciences Research Council in New York and serves on the editorial boards of several local and international journals in the field of international relations.
