Concerned about Plagiarism?

Are you being responsible and proactive in preventing plagiarism?

Turnitin can help! Students can learn how to use academic sources with integrity while lecturers can provide sleek feedback. All lecturers and students registered at the university can access it from clickUP. Why wait?

There are still a few **Turnitin** workshops this year, presented by dr Lynette Nagel from Education Innovation, each with a different user focus. All workshops are practical and hands-on, where you submit and evaluate your own documents on the system.

1. Comprehensive Turnitin workshop on 29 October

This one is aimed at lecturers who teach at any academic level, from first-year to post-graduate, for whom appropriate **Turnitin** assignments should be planned and created. This will include:

- a. Classes where everybody submits assignments on the same topic; by using suitable search and repository functions (**Undergraduate settings**)
- b. Post-graduate students and researchers who submit individual research papers (**Postgraduate settings**)
- c. Marking and using rubrics (**Grademark**)
- d. Providing feedback using coloured highlights, bubble comments, in-line comments and audio comments (**Grademark**)
- e. Using Peer review for students to engage with papers in a structured way and provide formative feedback (**PeerMark**).

2. Post-graduate supervisor workshop on 13 November.

This is an abbreviated version of the Comprehensive workshop and will only address the **Turnitin** settings applicable to research papers and theses.
