How to apply for funding:

Applicants can apply by following the steps below:

- Applications must be submitted through an online application process to the National Research Foundation (NRF). (see above)
- **Register/ Login using your ID number and password.**
- Select create new application from the list of existing calls.
- Select the call for which you are applying to: DAAD-NRF In-Country Scholarships Programme 2014

- Remember to complete all sections of the application.
- **Please attach the necessary documents in one PDF file in the following order: ID document, proof of permanent residence, university employment letter (if applicable) and certified academic certificates and transcripts, recommendation by supervisor (Compulsory for doctoral applicants), letter of admission (if available) and any reference letters (if available).**
- **N.B.:** Should you not follow the guidelines for attaching the necessary documents your application will not be considered.
- Remember to **submit** your application on completion.
- Complete applications will go to the host university for verification (Post Graduate Desk at CSC) before being forwarded to the NRF for further processing.
- Incomplete applications will not be considered.
- Applications that do not meet the eligibility criteria will not be considered.

The UP Internal closing date for submitting applications is 6 August 2013.
