LOUIS DREYFUS - WEIDENFELD SCHOLARSHIP

The Louis Dreyfus-Weidenfeld Scholarship and Leadership Programme provides outstanding postgraduate students and young professionals with the opportunity to pursue fully-funded **post graduate studies** (MSc, MPhil and DPhil) at the University of Oxford. The scholarship is complemented by a comprehensive programme of leadership skills development.

Who is eligible?

- Exceptional graduate students and young professionals from emerging economies in **Africa, Asia and South America** with **demonstrated leadership potential**. Successful applicants must have an interest in serving the global community through their chosen field of work, including but not limited to, agriculture, health care, environmental and water management, economic, public and foreign policy. They should have a commitment to pursuing diverse careers within the agro-business sector with a focus on improving food security and sustainability.

Which courses are covered?

- The Louis Dreyfus-Weidenfeld Scholarships are available for a **range of postgraduate courses (MSc, MPhil and DPhil)** at the University of Oxford. A specific list of eligible courses is attached and available on the Oxford website (link below)

What does it include?

- **100% of university and college fees** and a grant covering living costs
- The Louis Dreyfus-Weidenfeld Scholarships and Leadership Programme also includes a comprehensive **programme of leadership development, long-term mentoring and networking**
