



## **STATOMET BURSARIES 2014**

### **GENERAL**

STATOMET makes a limited number of bursaries available for **exceptional achievers** towards post graduate study in Statistics or Mathematical Statistics at the University of Pretoria.

### **BURSARIES DETAIL FOR FULLTIME HONOURS STUDENTS**

Annual bursary amount: R27 000.

Half of the bursary is paid into their student account on 1<sup>st</sup> March upon proof of their registration as a fulltime honours student for the year. The second half is paid into their student account on 1<sup>st</sup> of August provided they performed satisfactorily during the first semester (proof required).

Bursary holders may be appointed as student assistants in the department of Statistics for not more than 12 hours per week and must accept such appointment if offered to them by the department.

There is no restriction on any other bursaries a student may hold

### **BURSARIES FOR FULLTIME MASTERS STUDENTS.**

Annual bursary amount: R27 000

Half of the bursary is paid into their student account on 1<sup>st</sup> March upon proof of their registration as a fulltime masters student for the year. The second half is paid into their student account on 1<sup>st</sup> of August provided they performed satisfactorily during the first semester ( proof required )and is still registered as a fulltime student .

Dissertation completion incentive: R13 500

An amount of R13 500 is paid into the student account when the dissertation for the masters degree is completed and approved provided it is within 2 years of starting with the thesis.

Bursary holders may be appointed as student assistants in the department of Statistics for not more than 12 hours per week and must accept such appointment if offered to them by the department.

There is no restriction on any other bursaries a student may hold

**BURSARIES FOR FULLTIME PhD STUDENTS.**

Annual bursary amount: R27 000

Half of the bursary is paid into their student account on 1<sup>st</sup> March upon proof of their registration as a fulltime doctoral student for the year. The second half is paid into their student account on 1<sup>st</sup> of August provided they performed satisfactorily during the first semester ( proof required) and is still registered as a fulltime student .

Dissertation completion incentive: R13 500

An amount of R13 500 is paid into the student account when the dissertation for the doctoral degree is completed and approved provided it is within 2 years of starting with the thesis.

Bursary holders may be appointed as student assistants in the department of Statistics for not more than 12 hours per week and must accept such appointment if offered to them by the department.

A student may be awarded a bursary for a maximum of two years.

There is no restriction on any other bursaries a student may hold

**BURSARIES FOR JUNIOR STAFF/ ASSISTANT LECTURERS STUDYING PART TIME FOR A MASTERS DEGREES**

STATOMET provide bursaries for junior staff / assistant lecturers studying part time for a masters degree.

The amount of the bursaries is R13 500 per year for two years ( i.e. R27 000 in total over two years) provided the student registers for at least half of the required courses during the first year and for the rest of the courses during the second year and an amount of R13 500 on completion and approval of the thesis for the masters degree provided it is within 2 years of starting with the thesis.
