Prof Nkomo is Professor in die Department van Menslike Hulpbronbestuur. Voor sy diens aan die Universiteit van Pretoria aanvaar het, was sy die Bateman Professor of Business Leadership aan die Universiteit van Suid-Afrika se Nagraadse Skool vir Sakeleiers.

Haar werk oor ras en geslag en die hantering van diversiteit word internasionaal hoog aangeslaan en haar navorsing word in top internasionale vaktydskrifte gepubliseer. Saam met prof Ella LJ Bell van die Harvard Business School Press is sy medeouteur van die boek, *Our Separate Ways: Black and White Women and the Struggle for Professional Identity*. Sy word in die *International Who's Who in the Management Sciences* vir haar baanbrekersnavorsing oor ras en geslag in organisasies gelys.

Sy dien op die redaksionele rade van 'n groot aantal internasionale vaktydskrifte en is mederedakteur van *Organization: The critical journal of organization, theory and society* en die *British Journal of Management*.

Prof Nkomo is Professor in the Department of Human Resource Management. Prior to joining the University of Pretoria she was the Bateman Professor of Business Leadership at the University of South Africa's Graduate School of Business Leadership.

Her work on race and gender and managing diversity is recognised internationally and her research has been published in top international journals. She is co-author with Prof Ella LJ Bell of the critically acclaimed Harvard Business School Press book, *Our Separate Ways: Black and White Women and the Struggle for Professional Identity*. She is listed in the International *Who's Who in the Management Sciences* for her pioneering research on race and gender in organisations.

She serves on the editorial boards of a large number of international journals and is associate editor for *Organization: The critical journal of organization, theory and society* and the *British Journal of Management*.

Prof Nkomo is the recipient of many awards. In 2008, she was selected as one of 100 distinguished global thought leaders from business, education and government to participate in the Society for Human Resource Management's Leadership Summit on Diversity and Inclusion held in Washington, D.C.

Prof Nkomo has a B2-rating from the NRF.
