Programme information

The research can be conducted by means of a dissertation (BKS 858), a dissertation and solo exhibition (BKS 859) or a dissertation and curated exhibition (BKS 860).

Admission requirements

1. Four-year bachelor's degree in Fine Arts **or** relevant honours degree
2. A weighted average of at least 65% at final-year level of the four-year bachelor's degree **or** a cumulative weighted average of at least 65% for an equivalent degree at honours level
3. An admissions essay may be required
4. An entrance/admissions examination may be required

Note: Additional work/modules may be required in order to reach the desired level of competency

Additional requirements

The Research Committee of the Department of Visual Arts must approve the application which includes a research proposal.
