If the research outline is officially approved, the candidate will be allowed to register and a supervisor will be appointed. The candidate will work under the guidance of his/her supervisor until the research is completed according to the rules and regulations of the University.

Admission requirements

- 1. Relevant honours degree
- 2. A cumulative weighted average of at least 65% for the honours degree
- 3. A solid knowledge-base of the Financial Management Sciences deemed to be sufficient by the Departmental Postgraduate Committee

Additional requirements

A completed qualification at NQF level 8 with a solid knowledge base of the Financial Management Sciences deemed to be sufficient by the relevant head of department.
