- Selection will be based on academic performance in second-year and third-year Psychology modules
 - A weight of 40% will be allocated to the second-year mark in Psychology and a weight of 60% to the third-year mark in Psychology. The combined mark of the weighted second- and third year marks will be used to rank candidates
