  2. At least 65% for the research component at master's level **or** below 65% for the research component at master's level:

    - other academic qualifications and
    - the merit of the research topic
  3. An admissions examination may be required
  4. A portfolio consisting of:
    - copy of the preceding master's research component
    - recent research-based essays or assignments
    - a letter of motivation
