Selection Process

Candidates will be subjected to a selection process:

- Candidates will be required to complete an application form with two references and an essay
- Candidates will be required to complete a prescribed entrance assessment
- Should an applicant be non-degreed, they will be required to complete a prescribed entrance



assessment in line with RPL policy (UP General Academic Regulations and Student Rules, G.55). All non-degreed applicants will be required to attend panel interviews

- Once an applicant has completed the application process, the application will be submitted, via Faculty Board, to the Senate Committee for consideration
- Once all the required processes have been completed, the applicant is informed of the outcome of the application
