In this module students are equipped with the necessary knowledge, skills, values and attitude needed to apply in practice and to develop and enhance the inherent musicality of all learners. Since Music Education is based on sound and active involvement in music, this module focuses on the methodology of performance based activities. The methodology of music education and choral conducting is integrated.
