### Module content

The module comprises the following themes: history of the different phases of education in South Africa and different teaching methods used in each phase; The NCS and CAPS processing (scheme of work; schedule and assessment); multiple Intelligences; facilitating grammar lessons; facilitating literature lessons; facilitating creative writing lessons and marking of letters and compositions; questioning skills for facilitating assessment (methods, techniques and tools); and using technology in teaching.

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
