Intervention with a group of children with hearing loss in an educational setting. Parent guidance for families of children with hearing loss. Fitting, verification, orientation and validation of hearing aids in the paediatric population. Intervention in terms of follow-up and ongoing assessment, counselling and parent guidance. Observation of cochlear implant MAPping and intervention. Application of professional skills in all contexts (primary, secondary and tertiary health care contexts). Private practice administration and business management.
