3. An admissions essay may be required

Note: Additional work/modules may be required in order to reach the desired level of competency

### Additional requirements

- An acceptable level of proficiency in English or Afrikaans is a requisite.
- Prospective students may be required to submit an admissions essay or to do additional work/modules to enable them to reach the desired level of study.
- An approved research proposal is required.
